

## Prospective Students Q&A About The Healing Feats Reflexology Program

**How many in-class hours are in the program?**

320 total and depending on if you take on-site campus electives or off site, on campus *required hours include 140hrs* and you may take up to 15 hours more on campus electives, plus in the future we may be offering the 80 hours of A&P which would mean you could take up to 235 on-campus hours. 85 hours are off site, documented reflexology sessions.

**Are there any prerequisites to the program?**

Yes—but they are pre-requisites for CERTIFICATION—in other words, you don't have to take the pre-requisites to *get into* the class, but you will need to complete them before you receive your certification for the program. The pre-req is Anatomy & Physiology—75 class hours.

**What subjects are covered in the program?**

[E-mail us](#) on how to get a Student Catalog—we'll send your request to the host school in your area. But basically the program is broken down to body systems, also covers business, marketing, etc.

**Does the school have a particular slant on Reflexology such as from an energy viewpoint?**

Not in particular, but if you like Frankie's book on reflexology, ([The Complete Idiot's Guide to Reflexology](#)) then you know the philosophy, etc.

**Is Reflexology knowledge supported by courses in business or communication skills?**

Yes.

**How long does it take to complete the program?**

For the current, upcoming Idaho program, the following applies: The program scheduled to begin in Jan 2004 will be done in 5-day Modules—which will be one week at a time, Jan, Feb, March and April. Then the documentation needs to be done, which you get 6 mos to complete.

Also the pre-reqs need to be completed—so it will depend on how long it takes you to finish those—otherwise, the classes are complete in 4 months.

**Does the program offer certification or diploma of completion upon conclusion of a course beyond the introductory level?**

Yes.

**What is the maximum number of students per class? Or, what is the teacher-student ratio?**

Limited to 35 with an Assistant Teacher. Most classes are expected to be 10-20

**If advertised as a school, is the school licensed, by the State's Department of Post Secondary Education?**

Contact the host school direct to find out—but for the Boise classes in 2004 classes are held in a legitimate school—The European Academy of Advanced Esthetics, 208-672-0909.

**What is the total cost of tuition?**

This will vary btw the host schools that adopt the program. But the average is about \$750.00 per Module. There are 3 core Modules you must take, and the electives can also be taken in a Module—or you may be able to receive credit for some electives you've already taken at other schools.
